The Great Commission Conference enters its second year with a new name and broader focus. This annual event encourages, equips, and challenges Missouri Baptists to transform lives and communities with the gospel.

The unifying theme this year is "Re:concile — ambassadors of hope for transformation." The theme, drawn from 2 Cor. 5:17-20, informs the biblical preaching and teaching, musical worship, transformation talks, and networking during the conference.

The teaching elevates your biblical understanding of disciple-making and evangelism with an emphasis on the need for revival and renewal in your church.
