Project 360: Sound House, Lebanon- Provides a place for homeless students to do homework, eat a meal, shower, etc.

Number of participants needed: 15

Sorting and stocking clothes in clothes closet/ organizing kitchen shelves

Requested items: Small plastic food storage containers

COPE House, Lebanon- Shelter for victims of domestic violence.

Number of participants needed: 8 (must fill out a confidentiality form upon arrival)

Trim bushes, planting flowers, pulling weeds, etc.

Requested items: Diapers, formula, pillowcases, wash cloths

The Free Store Ministry, Lebanon- Provides clothing, food, housewares, financial assistance to those in need. Provides school supplies, Thanksgiving, Christmas and Easter give-aways.

Number of participants needed: 10

Sorting and preparing items for the Easter Giveaway which will be held the next day. Making sure the baskets, rabbits and books/Bibles are clean and ready to distribute. Taking inventory of what we have and need as well as counting any fillers we may have received.

Requested items: Bibles, Easter basket fillers (small toys, candy, etc.), Non-perishable food items, toilet paper, soap, shampoo, laundry soap.

Pregnancy Support Center, Lebanon- Provides pregnancy testing, ultra sounds, counseling, clothing closet, home for expectant mothers, adoption education, abstinence classes.

Number of participants needed: 8

Help with general cleaning, window cleaning, and yard work {4 cleaning (including the windows), 4 doing yard work}.

Requested items: diapers, wipes, onesies, infant socks, wash cloths, towels

ON SITE PROJECTS: (First Baptist Church, Lebanon)

Great Outdoors Day, Laclede Associational Camp- We will be putting stickers with Bible verses on zip lock bags and stuffing them with cookies. These will be given out the next day at the Great Outdoors Day Event.

Number of participants needed: 5

Laclede Association Sewing Ministry- Nancy LaChance facilitates this ministry in our association. They make pillow case dresses, and tote bags to be sent overseas in OCC shoeboxes, or with those going on mission to distribute.

Number of participants needed: unlimited

Sorting fabric and cutting out patterns. If some would like to sew they may bring their own machines or we have 4 that could be provided on that day. **Please bring scissors to cut fabric.**
