Off-SITE PROJECTS:

- Good Samaritan Center 108 S. Thompson Avenue, Excelsior Springs, MO. Thrift store & pantry. (10-12 women)
 Approximately 10 miles away, transportation provided. They can use 10-12 people to sort items, hang clothing
 or stock shelves with items that have been donated. They would welcome non-perishable food items or gently
 used clothing.
- Meet the Need 1302 N. Jesse James Road, Excelsior Springs, MO. Thrift store and pantry. (10-12 women)
 Approximately 8 miles away, transportation provided. They additionally have a café where they train people in cooking and food service. May be a good place for your lunch! They can use 10-12 people to sort, hang or stock shelves. They would also welcome donations of non-perishable food and nice clothing appropriate for work.
- 3. <u>Fulfillment House</u> 115 W. Washington Street, Kearney, MO. Shelter workshop for special needs teens and adults. (5-6 women) We need women willing to get their hands dirty. They have asked us to **plant flowers in the front flower bed**, "since it will almost be spring". They will supply dirt, plants fertilizer, tools, etc. Several of the young special needs adults may want to help. *Of course this will depend on the weather*!
- 4. Fulfillment House 115 W. Washington Street, Kearney, MO. Shelter workshop for special needs teens and adults. (6-10 women) They have asked us to assemble boxes. The employees do that and fill orders, but cannot stay ahead on boxes. They would be thrilled if we could make 200-300 that morning. These are small boxes, approx. 8X10X2 that are shipped to them flat, just need folding out/securing.

ON-SITE PROJECTS: (at First Baptist Church, Kearney)

- 1. Sewing project. Lap robes for area hospice patients. (10-12 women)
 - Approximate finished size will be 45 X 36.
 - Fabric and thread will be provided. A few sewing machines are available, so we are asking if you have one easily transported to consider bringing it as well as scissors, pins and **light weight batting.** Simple design of 2 fabric pieces cut 1 inch larger than finished project, and one batting piece.
- 2. Simple sock baby dolls for First Baptist Kearney's mission trips to Haiti. (10-12 women) Pattern will be available. This will be mainly hand sewing and stuffing with fiberfill. If you have partial boxes of fiberfill, please consider donating for this project. We will be looking for tan/brown socks to make the doll faces and will also need patterned socks for the body. Please bring any you find to be suitable. We will have needles and heavy thread and yarn for this project.
- Write thank you and encouragement cards with scriptures (10-15 women)
 Write cards of encouragement for Disaster Relief workers (will be used on the Disaster Relief Laundry Unit).
 Blank cards, envelopes, thank you cards, pens, markers and Bible verses will be provided.

Collecting for Liberty Women's Clinic, a Biblically-based crisis pregnancy center: \$5.00 gift cards to Walmart, Target, CVS or Walgreens. They give these to women in need of baby supplies.
