



PRAYER & EVANGELISM

Sports Evangelism	\$15,000
Support the MBC's partnership with Sports Crusaders, which includes sports camps co-sponsored by MBC churches, inner-city sports camps, associational camps, Esports camps/tournaments, and international mission efforts.	
Student Evangelism Conference	\$8,000
Host a statewide student evangelism/discipleship event in 2026 to train and inspire students to invest in their friends' lives to lead them to faith in Jesus.	
VBS Regional Training Events	\$8,000
Provide training in churches and associations to equip leaders to more effectively utilize VBS community ministry – one of the most widely used and effective evangelism tools in Missouri Baptist church life.	
Resounding Disciples	\$5,000
Engage MBC churches in a process of making healthy disciples through training, coaching/consulting, and resources.	
Baptist Evangelism Tent at State Fair	\$3,000
Share the gospel with visitors to the Missouri State Fair through a tent hosted by the Missouri DOM Fellowship; 38 came to faith in Christ in 2024.	
Students' Preaching Lab	\$2,500
Host a statewide preaching lab for student ministry leaders to develop their preaching abilities and build relationships.

COLLEGIATE MINISTRIES

Summer Missions Mentoring Initiative	\$105,000
Provide missions training and field experience for college students by placing them with church planters, church staff members, directors of missions, and independent ministry centers affiliated with MBC churches or associations.	
Collegiate Interns and Apprentices	\$22,000
Provide training and field experience for student leaders who are sensing a call to collegiate ministry, thus creating a pipeline of student leaders who become campus missionaries on one of our state's unreached campuses.	
Redemption Ranch Youth Camp	\$15,000
Equip and deploy 10 college-age counselors to mentor 450 students over three weeks, pouring into the students with evangelism, discipleship, worship, small-group studies, and intentional quiet times.

MISSIONS MOBILIZATION

Partnership Missions	\$40,000
Partner with MBC-affiliated churches and their members to fulfill the Great Commission by engaging them in missions at home and around the world.	

Missouri WMU	\$38,000
Support WMU ministries across the state, including age-level events and the annual Missions Celebration; assist with leadership training, board meetings, and WMU resources.	
Total – Missions Mobilization	\$78,000

DISASTER RELIEF

Disaster Relief Readiness	\$76,000
Maintain or replace disaster-relief equipment; upgrade the Readiness Center; develop DR leaders; help fund transportation for volunteer mobilization; and communicate DR ministries.	
Disaster Relief Collegiate Internship	\$27,800
Fund collegiate internships using DR as a platform to teach leadership and disaster-relief skills and promote spiritual development.	
Disaster Relief Emergency Food Fund	\$10,000
Help maintain a par level of \$50,000 in the Disaster Relief Food Fund. The amount varies from year to year.	
Hunger Relief Network	\$7,500
Assist MBC churches and ministries as they seek to reduce hunger and share the gospel.	
Baptist Builders	\$1,000
Sustain and improve the network that connects church volunteers with construction needs.

CHURCH PLANTING / SEND MISSOURI

Strategic Missionary Development	\$35,000
Provide strategy-based resources for discipling, coaching, and mentoring current and future church planters, their wives, and/or sending churches.	
Next Step Requests	\$30,000
Provide financial assistance to church planters in various stages of establishing new congregations and assist overseas partner churches with training and mobilization.

CHURCH RENEWAL

Resound Network	\$35,000
Equip, encourage, and resource leaders of plateaued or declining churches to enable them to return to health and kingdom growth.	
Leader Care Network	\$22,000
Connect church leaders with systems of care, refreshment, and development; improve their leadership skills so they are better equipped to share the gospel.	
MBC New Pastors Retreat	\$20,500
Identify the unique needs of senior pastors and their spouses in their first MBC churches or in churches in the revitalization process; provide coaching, equipping, and encouragement.	



Church Leader Development	\$10,000
Provide church leaders with training, resources, and networking opportunities to help them become more successful leaders in their churches and communities.	
Pathway Journalism Retreat	\$2,000
Train <i>Pathway</i> contributing writers and photographers from MBC-affiliated universities, as well as Spurgeon College at Midwestern Seminary; mobilize a new generation of Southern Baptists to pursue Christian journalism.

ENTITY RELATIONS *

Intensive In-Home Services (MBCH)	\$20,000
Launch new initiative to minister to 75-100 families in crisis by providing counseling, parenting education, child-development training, household maintenance, and nutritional training.	
Freedom on the Inside (HLGU)	\$10,000
Support HLGU's initiative to offer a four-year biblical studies degree within the Jefferson City Correctional Center, with a curriculum geared toward moral rehabilitation and service to others.	
Anti-trafficking Services (MBCH)	\$10,000
Provide group-home living for minor girls who are survivors of human trafficking.	
Family Resource Development (MBCH)	\$10,000
Recruit, train, and prepare foster and relative families to become licensed and to care for children in their homes.	
Family Foster Care (MBCH)	\$10,000
Provide case-management services for children and youth in state custody and their families to work toward safe and permanent environments.	
Transitional Living Program (MBCH)	\$9,000
Support group-home and apartment living for youths aged 16-21, supplying training programs to develop independent living skills.	
Church Engagement (MBCH)	\$8,500
Equip churches and communities to respond to the needs of children, youth, adults, and families.	
Therapeutic Group Homes (MBCH)	\$7,800
Provide residential care for teen girls with moderate to severe trauma needs.	
Gospel-centered Healthcare Professional Development (BHHM)	\$7,500
Establish gospel-centered professional development at each Baptist Homes campus, led by local church leaders and emphasizing a clear call to faith in Jesus Christ.	
Soul Care Mentorship (BHHM)	\$7,500
Mentor the supervisory staff in "soul care," an ongoing evangelism and discipleship ministry to residents, family members, and staff at all facilities.	
Intellectually and Developmentally Disabled Adults (MBCH)	\$7,500
Support a group home for adults with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities.

Maternity Home and In-home Pregnancy Services (MBCH)	\$7,500
Provide on-campus and in-home pregnancy services for minors and adults.	
Treatment Family Care (MBCH)	\$5,000
Provide support to relative families and foster parents to care for children and youth with moderate to severe trauma needs.	
Counseling Services (MBCH)	\$5,000
Offer Christian counseling for individuals, couples, and families.	
Viable: The Business of Ministry (MBF)	\$5,000
Provide "Viable: The Business of Ministry" resources to strengthen the financial leadership skills of Missouri Baptist pastors through books, online courses, in-person regional gatherings, and mentoring.	
MBU Missions Mobilization	\$5,000
Partner with the International Mission Board and local churches to train and deploy students for missions at home and around the world. Key global destinations include Mexico and Greece.	
SBU Center for Global Connections Missions Training Program	\$3,000
Provide training events that equip up to 30 team leaders and up to 100 students who engage in missions in the U.S. and around the world.	
Church and State Pastoral Reading Groups (SBU)	\$2,000
Host workshops that help students and pastors thoughtfully engage in political discourse and civic life.	
Pastor/Staff and Wives Dinner (Christian Life Commission)	\$1,400
Host dinner for pastors, staff, and their wives on the eve of the MBC Annual Meeting; inform attendees of the work of the CLC.
