





HOW MMO HELPS ASSOCIATIONS

Ten percent of your church's gifts to MMO is returned to your association to support missions.

HERE'S HOW SEVERAL ASSOCIATIONS ARE INVESTING THESE RETURNS.

- Cape Girardeau Baptist Association** (John Vernon) partnered with Access, a ministry to individuals with disabilities/special needs and their family members, helping create a community for them.
- Concord Baptist Association** (Alan Earls) funded a summer missionary who served CBA churches through Vacation Bible School, Concord Builder's missionary trip, Associational Children's Camp, and the Mid-Missouri Mission's Team (3MT). Remaining MMO funds helped offset the costs of background checks for Children's Camp volunteers.
- Dent County Baptist Association** (Keith Vawter) assisted with a countywide school backpack event.
- Franklin Baptist Association** (James Plymale) used MMO funds to pay half the cost of a new trailer for block parties. The association also helped fund local and county fair ministries, and helped underwrite expenses for a partnership with churches in southern Wisconsin.
- Gasconade Valley Baptist Association** (Trent Young) helped fund two summer missionaries who served the churches of the association.
- Greene County Baptist Association** (Joshua Hall) supported Deaf Youth Camp; helped fund an ethnic pastors Christmas dinner; blessed pastors and wives with two different fellowship nights; and blessed pastors and wives with a free Christmas dinner and night of fellowship.
- Laclede Baptist Association** (Bradley Jemes) helped a sister church in the Minnesota/Wisconsin partnership, taking volunteers to assist with Vacation Bible schools, block parties, outreach and evangelism, and minor construction and landscaping.
- Lamine Baptist Association** (Russ Slocum) led the Missouri State Fair ministry, which resulted in 38 professions of faith, eight rededications, and two connections to local churches. In addition, MMO funds were used to help children attend summer camp, as well as support disaster relief efforts.
