Goal \$825,000

PRAYER & EVANGELISM

Evangelism & Outreach Grants	\$24,000
Provide financial support to MBC-affiliated churches for evangelism and outreach in their communities.	
Student Evangelism Conference	\$12,000
Host a statewide student evangelism/discipleship event in 2027 to train and inspire students to invest in their friends' lives to lead them to faith in Jesus.	
VBS Regional Training Events	\$10,000
Provide training in churches and associations to equip leaders to more effectively utilize VBS community ministry – one of the most widely used and effective evangelism tools in Missouri Baptist church life.	
Discipleship	\$5,000
Engage MBC churches in a process of making healthy disciples through training, coaching/consulting, and resources.	
Super Summer Interns	\$5,000
Provide year-round ministry and training opportunities for interns engaged in Super Summer.	
State Fair Evangelism	\$5,000
Supplement the work of the DOM Fellowship to share the gospel with visitors to the Missouri State Fair through an evangelism tent.	
Student Minister Network	\$5,000
Develop a network of student ministry leaders to strengthen their skills, grow their ministries, and build relationships with other student leaders.	
Children's Minister Network	\$5,000
Support the development of a network for children's ministers across Missouri.	
Students' Preaching Lab	\$4,000
Host a statewide preaching lab for student ministry leaders to develop their preaching skills and build relationships with other ministry leaders.

COLLEGIATE MINISTRIES

Summer Missions	\$110,000
Provide missions training and field experience for more than 50 college students by placing them with church planters, church ministry leaders, directors of missions, and independent ministry centers affiliated with MBC churches or associations. The goal: to share the gospel with people of all ages in Missouri communities.	
Total – Collegiate Ministries	\$110,000

MISSIONS MOBILIZATION

Center Cross Academy	\$25,000
Partner with Center Cross Academy in St. Louis to provide scholarships to inner-city students to obtain a Christian education.	

School to the Nations	\$20,000
Partner with the School to the Nations to provide language resources and The Hope Film for Missouri Baptist teams that mobilize internationally.	
International Training for Pastors	\$15,000
Send Missouri Baptists to train pastors in nations where secondary and seminary education are not readily available..	
Strategic Missions	\$15,000
Help Missouri Baptists reach their church's Acts 1:8 vision by funding strategic mission projects.	
Total – Missions Mobilization	\$75,000

DISASTER RELIEF

Disaster Relief Readiness	\$79,250
Maintain, upgrade, or replace disaster-relief equipment; upgrade the Readiness Center; develop DR leaders; and help fund transportation for volunteer mobilization..	
Disaster Relief Collegiate Internship	\$21,500
Fund seven collegiate internships using DR as a platform to teach leadership and disaster relief skills and promote spiritual development.	
Disaster Relief Emergency Food Fund	\$10,000
Maintain a par level of \$50,000 in the Disaster Relief Food Fund.	
Hunger Relief Network	\$7,500
Assist MBC churches with hunger-related projects, and recruit churches to participate in ministries that seek to reduce hunger and share the gospel.	
Baptist Builders	\$1,000
Sustain and improve the network that connects church volunteers with construction needs.	
Total – Disaster Relief	\$119,250

CHURCH RENEWAL

Resound Network	\$20,000
Equip, encourage, and resource leaders of plateaued or declining churches to enable them to return to health and kingdom growth. Ministries involve a Resound Summit, Engaging Leaders events, summer cohorts and internships, church and leader development, and bivocational training.	
Discover MBC	\$20,000
Host a ministry retreat that enables associational leaders, pastors, and their spouses to become more acquainted with the ministry leaders and resources of the MBC for the purpose of transforming lives and communities with the gospel..	
Leader Care Network	\$16,000
Connect church leaders with systems of care, refreshment, and development; improve their leadership skills so they are better equipped to share the gospel. Ministries include coaching and counseling, as well as Leader Care Retreat assistance.

Women in Ministry \$15,000

Equipping and empowering Missouri Baptist women who are called by God to serve in their local churches. Ministries include a Women in Ministry Retreat and a Women in Leadership Retreat, women in leadership development events, resources for associational leaders' wives, cohorts, and engagement events at the MBC Annual Meeting.

Associational Leader Care \$4,000

Assist directors of missions and other associational leaders in the advancement of leadership and ministry skills.

Total – Church Renewal \$75,000

ENTITY RELATIONS

Missouri Baptist Children's Home \$75,000

Serve 2,000 children, youth, and families in Missouri through multiple ministries including: Stronger Family Services; Therapeutic Group Homes; Intellectually and Developmentally Disabled Services; Transitional Living Program; Pregnancy Services (Maternity Home & In-Home); Family Resource Development; Family Foster Care; Treatment Facility Care; Counseling Services; Church Engagement; Home Visitation Services; Housing Stability Program; and Pregnancy Outreach.

Baptist Homes & Healthcare Ministries \$13,000

Lead life-planning training for churches and associations; support the Seniors in God's Creation initiative to reactivate seniors in outdoor activities; equip healthcare workers through biblical worldview training; and prepare seniors for long-term care at Baptist Homes or other Missouri facilities.

Missouri Baptist Foundation \$13,000

Provide scholarships of \$500 – \$1,000 to pastors and staff members who complete estate plans with their attorneys of choice.

Hannibal-LaGrange University \$13,000

Support "Freedom on the Inside," HLGU's initiative to offer a four-year biblical studies degree to inmates at the Jefferson City Correctional Center in cooperation with the Missouri Department of Corrections. The curriculum is focused on moral rehabilitation and preparing students for a life of Christian service.

Missouri Baptist University \$13,000

Provide \$500 scholarships for 26 students serving on domestic and international mission trips in partnership with MBC-affiliated churches and the International Mission Board.

Southwest Baptist University \$13,000

Provide scholarships for students engaged in a wide range of domestic and international mission projects, including projects through Missouri Baptist Disaster Relief, the North American Mission Board, and the International Mission Board.

Total – Entity Relations \$140,000

AUXILIARY ORGANIZATIONS

Missouri WMU \$38,000

Support WMU ministries across the state, including age-level events – from grade school through college – and the annual Missions Celebration; assist with leadership training, board meetings, and WMU resources.

Sports Crusaders \$15,000

Support the MBC's partnership with Sports Crusaders, which includes sports camps cosponsored by MBC churches, associational camps, recreation camps, international mission efforts, and training for summer staff members who share the gospel through these activities.

Redemption Ranch Youth Camp \$15,000

Equip and deploy 10 college-age counselors/missionaries to mentor 450 students over three weeks, pouring into the students with evangelism, discipleship, worship, small-group studies, and intentional quiet times.

Missouri DOM Fellowship \$3,000

Share the gospel with visitors to the Missouri State Fair through an evangelism tent hosted by the Missouri DOM Fellowship.

Christian Life Commission \$2,000

Advocate public policy, bear witness to a faithful God who commanded us to be salt and light, and work to educate and inform Missouri Baptists about issues affecting families, communities, and nations.

Historical Commission \$2,000

Establish the Baptist Heritage Award to recognize congregations that demonstrate faithful obedience to Christ through a living heritage of prayer, evangelism, missions, church planting, and renewal.

Pathway Journalism Retreat \$2,000

Train *Pathway* contributing writers and photographers from MBC-affiliated universities, as well as Spurgeon College at Midwestern Seminary; mobilize a new generation of Southern Baptists to pursue Christian journalism.

Total – Auxiliary Organizations \$77,000

OTHER MINISTRIES

Church Residencies \$20,000

Provide financial support to MBC-affiliated churches to develop the next generation of ministry leaders.

Media & Communications \$10,000

Upgrade media gear used to support major MBC events like the annual meeting, evangelism conference, and student and collegiate events. Provide resources for new and existing MBC communications efforts in the areas of AI research, video production, and podcasting to better serve Missouri Baptist churches.

Total – Other Ministries \$30,000

APPROVED REQUESTS FOR FUNDING \$701,250

STANDING PERCENTAGE ALLOCATIONS

Promotion – 5% \$41,250

Provide all graphic design, printing, postage, web, social media, and video resources at no cost to participating MBC-affiliated churches.

Associational Partnerships – 10% \$82,500

Partner in missions with Southern Baptist associations in Missouri.
