

## WHERE YOUR GIFTS GO

Want to know how your MMO contributions help churches transform lives and communities with the gospel?

Even your chump change goes a long way!

Your gifts of any size support prayer and evangelism, church planting and renewal, missions mobilization, collegiate ministries, disaster relief, ministries at six affiliated entities, and more. Here's a sampling:

- \$1** provides a "Little Debbie" moment – a snack like a Christmas tree cake – to seniors participating in Baptist Homes fellowship events.
- \$5** delivers a *Viable* book from the Missouri Baptist Foundation that equips ministry leaders with practical tools to build healthy, sustainable ministries.
- \$8** secures a Bible for a disaster survivor.
- \$17** buys a multi-colored soccer ball designed to share the gospel with participants in sports camps.
- \$30** provides a case of diapers for a Children's Home client.
- \$35** registers a girl in grades 1–6 for G.E.M. (Girls Experiencing Missions).
- \$50** sends an at-risk child to a Sports Crusaders camp; or it covers the cost of resources for Women in Ministry.
- \$56** secures resources for a Backyard Kids Club that enables a church to share the gospel with 50 children.
- \$70** provides respite care for a Missouri Baptist foster family through the Children's Home.
- \$75** equips a church and its leaders for renewal through the Resound Network.
- \$100** adopts an International Mission Board missionary kid returning to the states so he or she can attend MK Reentry.
- \$125** supports nursing students at Missouri Baptist University serving in overseas health clinics; or it provides a tarp, tub, and food for survivors of tornadoes.
- \$135** covers course fees for one credit hour for a nursing student at Southwest Baptist University's Mercy College of Health Professions.
- \$150** supports a Southwest Baptist University student serving on an overseas mission trip through the Center for Global Connections; or it helps equip college interns with professional nonprofit financial training at the Missouri Baptist Foundation.
- \$175** provides Leader Care counseling for a pastor and/or spouse.
- \$200** buys curriculum for Freedom on the Inside, an initiative of Hannibal-LaGrange University to offer a four-year biblical studies degree within the Jefferson City Correctional Center.
- \$270** helps a woman earn a leadership certificate through the Christian Women's Leadership Center of the national WMU.
- \$300** establishes a wild bird feeding station at a Baptist Homes campus.
- \$400** buys weighted blankets for five Baptist Homes residents to help reduce stress and anxiety and provide a better night's sleep.
- \$600** funds a collegiate summer missionary for a month as he or she serves alongside MBC ministry leaders..
- \$1,000** provides 200 hot meals for disaster survivors.
