Worship Leader / Minister of Music

Principle Function: The minister of music is responsible to the pastor for planning, conducting and promotion of the music and worship programs of the church.

Ministry Requirements and Responsibilities:

- 1. Direct the planning, organizing, conducting and evaluating of the church music program, including choirs, praise teams and other vocal and instrumental groups.
- 2. Supervise the work of paid music staff and volunteer workers.
- 3. Work with the Church Nominating Committee to enlist and train leaders for the church music and worship ministry, including accompanists and graded choir leaders.
- 4. Serve as a member of the Church Council; coordinate the music and worship program with the church calendar and emphases of the church.
- 5. Lead in planning and promoting a graded choir program; direct and coordinate the work of choir directors. Direct adult, student and other choirs as needed.
- 6. Assist the pastor in planning all worship services.
- 7. Arrange and provide music for weddings, funerals, special events and other church-related activities upon request.
- 8. Maintain music library, materials, supplies, musical instruments and other equipment.
- 9. Prepare an annual music and worship budget for approval. Administrate approved budget.
- 10. Cooperate with the local association and denominational leaders in promoting activities of mutual interest.
- 11. Perform other duties as assigned by Senior Pastor.
